These attributes of God are reflected in the mirror of the human heart. Children's classes are designed for children from age 5 to 11, and are taught using songs, art, stories and activities.

DYNAMIC LESSONS

Lessons include activities such as songs, stories, arts, crafts, and drama, which build on the central theme. Prayers and readings from the Bahá'í Writings which support that theme are also studied.

MINING GEMS

The Bahá'í Writings say that every person has within them "gems" - beautiful spiritual qualities - which cannot surface without effort, practice, striving and training.
